



SIGHT AND HEARING TEST

SAFER WORKING WITH TESTED SIGHT AND HEARING.

Impaired sight or hearing can adversely affect the safety and performance of employees. Testing a person's eyesight and capacity to perceive spatial and colour differences makes it possible to detect disorders at an early stage. The same applies to hearing tests. Regular examinations can help to prevent noise-induced hearing loss – one of the most common occupational diseases.

Target group

- › All employees
- › Main focus: manufacturing workers and workers in the construction industry

Goals

- › Identifying impairments at an early stage
- › Minimising the risk of accidents due to poor hearing or sight

Contents

Sight test:

- › Measurement of eye function (this can be done in minutes using the latest instruments). Assessment and recommendation for treatment.

Hearing test:

- › Measurement and assessment of hearing function using modern audiometer and otoscope.
- › Invitation to undergo a more in-depth examination if there is any loss of function.

Method

- › One-to-one consultation
- › Diagnostics

Implementation

- › Optician and hearing aid acoustics specialist

Number of attendees

- › Up to 26 people per day

Duration

- › 15 minutes per person and test

Location

- › On the company's premises or by arrangement
